**A CORUÑA PORT SELF-PROTECTION PLAN**

The Port Authority of A Coruña has a Self-Protection Plan whose scope of action includes the internal and external waters (zone II) of the port.

This self-protection plan has an emergency action plan that can be activated in case of emergency on board.

In the event of an emergency on board, the officer on duty shall declare the alert and communicate it to the Maritime Coordination and Rescue Centre (CCS/LCC-SASEMAR) by means of the following contact point:

**BASIC INFORMATION TO COMMUNICATE**

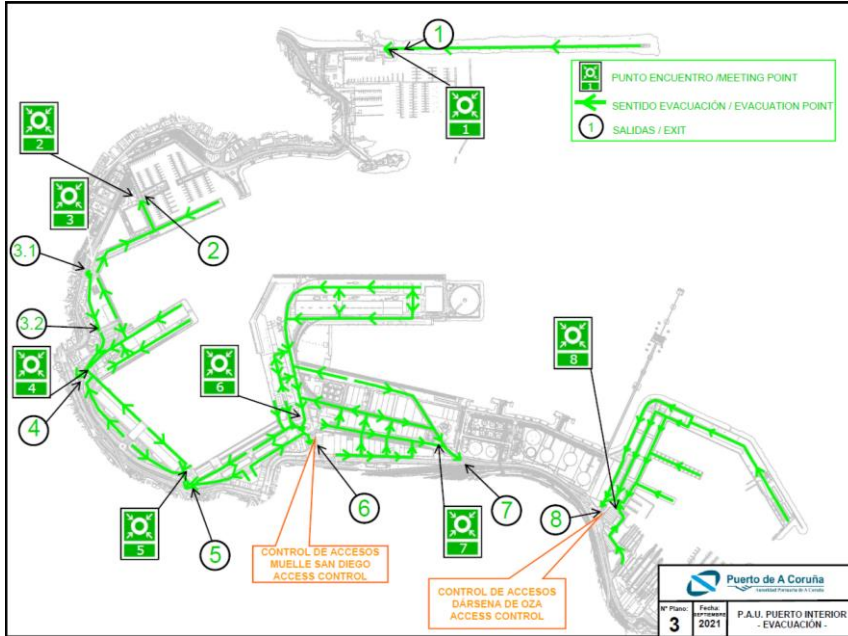
Identification of the caller
Vessel identification: nationality and vessel type
Position (berth, anchorage area)
Call sign
GT (Gross Registered Tonnage) - PM (Deadweight) Length - Draught
Cargo on board: Are you carrying MM.PP.? IMDG code and quantity of cargo.
Type of emergency (fire, explosion, spill, gas leakage, threat, sinking, etc.).
Other emergencies (spill, fire, etc.)?
Number of crew and passengers
Number of injured and condition, if any
If applicable, spilled material and quantity.
Condition of the vessel: water leaking, operating machinery, self-steering?
Units and vessels possibly threatened.
Traffic in the vicinity.
Environmental conditions in the area.
Time of onset of emergency.
Has SOPEP been activated?
Shipping agent

**IMMEDIATE ACTIONS IN CASE OF EMERGENCY**

Act according to the vessel's muster Lists and emergency instructions
Call the CCS/LCC Service Technician, communicating the emergency and basic information
